

SA Fellowship Preparation Program

16 – 18 March 2007

The Fellowship Preparation Program is organised by the RACGP SA&NT Faculty. The program is now in its fifth successful year and participants have found it most beneficial in the lead up to the exam.

This program is aimed at introducing participants to the five domains of general practice which are:

- communication skills and the patient doctor relationship
- applied professional knowledge and skills
- population health in the context of general practice
- professional and ethical role
- organisation and legal dimensions.

The 3 day program covers the curriculum areas essential for competent, unsupervised general practice. The sessions are highly interactive with small group activities and role playing. There are over 20 presenters, most of whom are experienced examiners.

Prereading material will be sent to applicants at least 1 week before the commencement of the program. It is important that the prereading material is considered before attending the program.
