

Schedule for GPR support and incentive subsidies

Relocation during training and at completion of training and not thereafter	To or within a rural location	Max \$1000 per calendar year	subsequent GPR may be able to access GPPHCNT subsidies (discussion underway)
	From rural location to Darwin	Max \$1000 per calendar year	
Relocation during training and at completion of training and not thereafter	To a remote location	Max \$5000 per calendar year	subsequent GPR may be able to access GPPHCNT subsidies (discussion underway)
	From remote location to a rural location or Darwin	Max. \$5000 per calendar year	
Courses applied and attend whilst living and training in rural and remote locations (applicable courses defined in claim form)	Rural location	Max. \$1000 per calendar year if unable to receive support from divisions or other funding sources	Membership of divisions – able to access resources for courses/CPD
	Remote location	Max. \$5,000 per Calendar year if unable to receive support from divisions or other funding sources	
IT Support	All GPRs	Max \$30 per month	To enable all GPR to access RRMEO and other online resources
Educational resources	Remote	Max. \$1000 per calendar year	
Rent Assistance	Rural and remote	Max. \$100 per week	Contingent on circumstances

Note:

- Reimbursement upon receipt of tax invoice or other agreed evidence of payment by the GPR.
- This schedule applies to all registrars (GPRs) working, training and residing in rural and remote areas and are involved in General Practice training with NTGPE¹.
- Limitations – for the purpose of this document rural means regional centres outside of Darwin (RRMA 4-6); remote means remote Aboriginal communities (RRMA 7)
